

ELECTRICIAN SKILLBRIDGE INTERNSHIP

This internship provides transitioning military members with an opportunity to learn all aspects of what it means to be an Electrician. You will assist in troubleshooting and repairing electric motors, fans, and lighting systems; and install lighting outlets, switches and receptacles. You will assist in maintaining and testing of emergency generator and fire alarm systems. You will receive comprehensive training and mentorship from seasoned professionals to prepare you for success. You will have an opportunity to work in a supportive team environment. The Virginia Beach Public Utilities department is where you can make a lasting impact while growing personally and professionally.

Duties include, but are not limited to:

- Participate in work involving preventive maintenance, distribution panels and equipment, circuit systems, controls and light fixtures.
- Participate in repairs, installation and maintenance of fire alarms, public address systems, enunciator and other communication systems to ensure proper operation and to prevent equipment failure.
- Generate work orders and daily log sheets in a neat and orderly fashion.
- Perform other job duties requiring skills, knowledge and physical requirements as demanded by those duties described or less. Individual assignments will be determined by the supervisor based on the current workload and department needs.

Minimum Qualifications:

Must be on active military duty with Skillbridge eligibility.
