

SURVEY TECHNICIAN SKILLBRIDGE INTERNSHIP

This internship provides transitioning military members with an opportunity to learn all aspects of what it means to be a Survey Technician. You will assist the City's survey team by participating in field operations, working closely with an engineering survey team to conduct measurements, update survey records, and ensure accuracy in utility mapping and property boundary delineation. The Virginia Beach Public Works department is where you can make a lasting impact while growing personally and professionally.

Duties include, but are not limited to:

- Receive, analyze, and process survey data, plats, deeds, and plans.
- Perform fieldwork and assist in survey operations, including measurements, GPS data collection, and boundary marking.
- Conduct research for property acquisition, easements, and subdivision records.
- Draft and edit technical drawings using GIS software and CAD systems.
- Assist with post-processing GPS, hydrographic, and volumetric data for city infrastructure projects.
- Review and process data from other city agencies and ensure accuracy in public utility surveys.
- Collaborate with engineers and city officials to ensure accurate survey documentation for public works.
- Prepare reports and support land acquisition and right-of-way processes.

Minimum Qualifications:

Must be on active military duty with Skillbridge eligibility.

Application Process:
