

ORDINANCE-3868

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 10-1.1 OF THE CITY CODE TO ADD THE PRINCESS ANNE AREA LIBRARY AS A LOCATION FOR ABSENTEE VOTING IN PERSON AND TO REMOVE MEYERA OBERNDORF CENTRAL LIBRARY AS A LOCATION FOR ABSENTEE VOTING IN PERSON

SECTION AMENDED: § 10-1.1

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VIRGINIA BEACH, VIRGINIA:

1. Section 10-1.1 of the City Code is hereby amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 10-1.1. Satellite absentee voting locations; notice.

(a) As authorized by Code of Virginia § 24.2-701.2, the satellite offices to be used in the city for absentee voting in person are the following locations:

Bayside Recreation Center, 4500 First Court Road.

Great Neck Recreation Center, 2521 Shorehaven Drive.

Seatack Recreation Center, 141 S. Birdneck Road.

~~Meyera Oberndorf Central Library, 4100 Virginia Beach Boulevard.~~

Kempsville Area Library, 832 Kempsville Road.

Princess Anne Library, 1444 Nimmo Parkway.

(b) The general registrar shall provide notice of such absentee voting locations at the office of the voter registrar and at the voter registrar's website. Such notice will include information regarding what time the location is available for in-person absentee voting and other pertinent details.

2. The Director of Elections (Voter Registrar) is hereby directed to seek a certification of no objection from the Office of the Attorney General using the preclearance procedure provided by Virginia Code § 24.2-129(D) for the satellite location change authorized herein. The precinct change shall not be administered unless and until the Attorney General has provided such certification or if 60 days lapses without the Attorney General interposing an objection.
